Losing an opener for the first time since 2004, the Colts fell at home to Chicago, 29-13, in the first regular-season contest in Lucas Oil Stadium. Indianapolis assumed a 3-0 first-quarter lead it could not hold, as Chicago rushed for 183 yards, produced a safety and scored a defensive touchdown in earning the win. The Colts mustered 53 rushing yards, while QB-Peyton Manning was 30-49-257, 1 TD passing. Chicago RB-Matt Forte was 23-123, 1 TD rushing, and his 50t burst in the opening period staked the Bears to the lead. The victory snapped a 21-game September/October winning streak for the Colts, as the club opened with 13-0, 9-0 and 7-0 records from 2005-07. The loss put Indianapolis in second-place in the AFC South, the first time the club did not top the standings or share the lead since October, 2004.

K-Adam Vinatieri booted a 47-yard field goal with :03 remaining to cap an 18-point second-half rally as the Colts topped Minnesota, 18-15. K-Ryan Longwell booted field goals of 45, 27, 53, 46 and 28 yards, but his miss from 48 yards mid-way through the final period helped set the comeback. QB-Peyton Manning (26-42-311, 1 TD/2 ints.) teamed with WR-Reggie Wayne (5-93, 1 TD) on a 32t strike with 5:54 left, and RB-Dominic Rhodes added the tying two-point conversion. Indianapolis forced a late punt to move into range for Vinatieri. The Vikings took the lead five minutes into the game, and Indianapolis played from behind most of the way. RB-Adrian Peterson rushed 29-160, while the Vikings tallied 180 rushing yards to the Colts' 25. WR-Anthony Gonzalez was 9-137, while WR-Marvin Harrison caught a pass in his 177th consecutive game, tying Steve Largent for the 4th-longest NFL streak.

Scoring 21 points in a 2:10 span of the final quarter, Indianapolis produced a stirring 31-27 victory at Houston. Indianapolis scored 10 first-quarter points before seeing Houston tally 27 unanswered points in taking a 17-point lead into the final minutes. QB-Peyton Manning (25-34-247, 2 TDs/1 int.) sandwiched 71 and 51 scoring passes to TE-Tom Santi and WR-Reggie Wayne (7-97) around LB-Gary Brackett's 681 fumble return as the Colts earned the win. The first scoring pass came with 4:04 remaining, and the final one came with 1:54 to go as Indianapolis became the first NFL team to erase a 17-point deficit in a game's final five minutes to win in regulation. The final touchdown was set up by DE-Robert Mathis' sack-fumble recovery at the Houston 20. DB-Melvin Bullitt intercepted a pass at the club's 22 with :42 remaining as the three late takeaways spurred the comeback. RB-Joseph Addai was 17-71, 1 TD rushing.

Bolting to a 24-0 halftime lead, the Colts posted a 31-3 victory over Baltimore. QB-Peyton Manning (19-28-271, 3 TDs) teamed with WRs-Marvin Harrison (3-83, 2 TDs; 67t; 5t) and Reggie Wayne (8-118, 1 TD; 22t) on first-half scoring tosses, while the club produced three of its five takeaways over the first 30 minutes. DE-Robert Mathis had three sacks and one forced fumble to help pace the defense. Harrison posted his 29th career multiple-TD reception game, while Wayne (51) moved into 3rd place in Colts career scoring receptions. Indianapolis yielded 51 rushing yards and controlled the game throughout. Manning (110, Harrison; 50, Wayne) became the 2nd NFL QB to have 50+ career touchdown connections with two different receivers [79, Dan Marino-Mark Clayton; 55, Marino-Mark Duper]. The victory was the club's 14th consecutive in October, dating back to 2005, one game shy of the best October totals since the 1970 NFL Merger (14, Miami, 1971-74; 14, Denver, 1983-86).

Dungy became the only post-Merger coach to lead 10 consecutive teams to the playoffs. Indianapolis (6, 2003-08) tied the NFL mark for most consecutive 11+-victory seasons (6, Dallas, 1976-81). This marked the club's fourth road win after trailing by 10+ points, tying the NFL seasonal mark of Dallas (1983), and it was the third road win after trailing by 14+ points, setting a new NFL seasonal record.
